Fruit Tuck

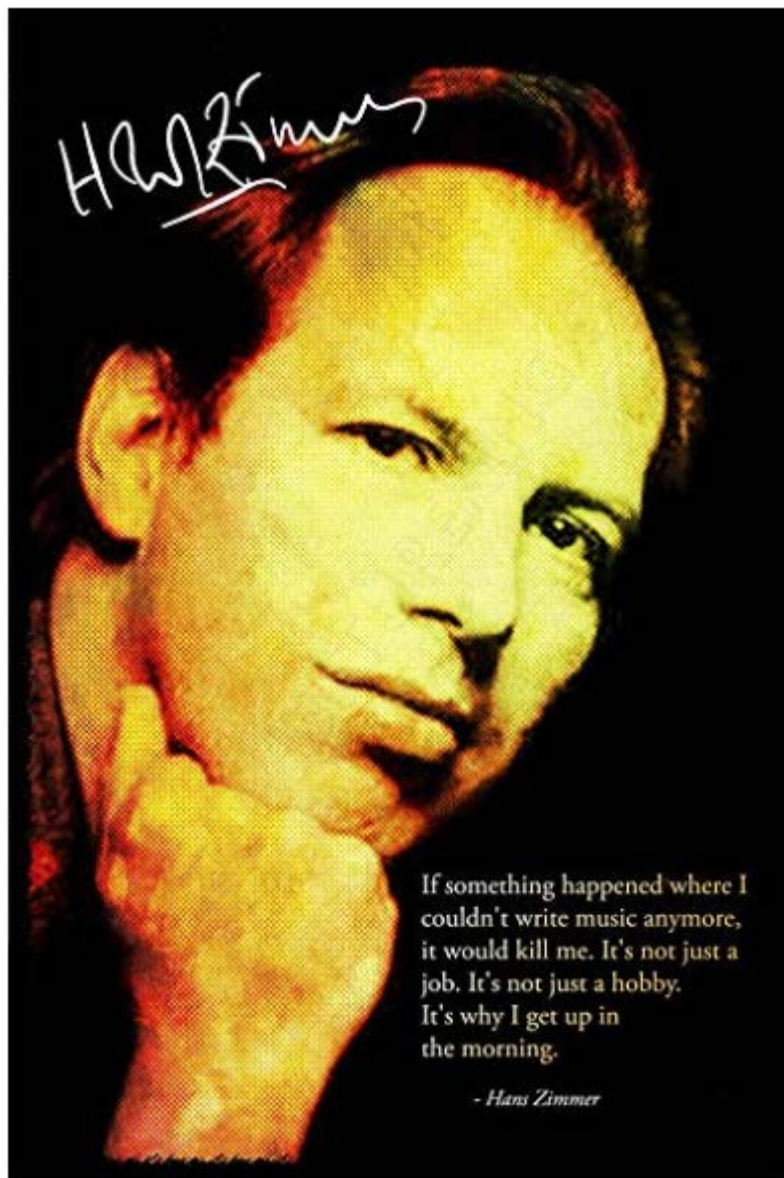
