Digital Leaders Update

We were recently visited by the 'Two Johns' for a presentation about online safety. We learned about how to stay safe online when using apps such as TikTok, Roblox and Snapchat. We also learned why it's important that we don't send any photos to strangers online because it can give away where we are because of the embedded location data.

The children shared that they are sometimes afraid of telling adults if they see something inappropriate online because they are worried that they are going to be told off. It is essential that our children know that they will not get into trouble and that we are always here to support them if something happens online. Remember, the children are not at fault - it's the strangers online that misuse the internet that makes it so dangerous. The children's class teachers and Digital Leaders are always on hand if the children wish to discuss any concerns during the school day.

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

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
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
